East aisle window, nearest the entrance, devoted to Saint Mark and Eunice, Mother of Timothy.

Saint Mark bears the evangelical pen and ^{scroll} book with his traditional symbol of the winged lion inscribed on the latter.

Eunice bears an open book, suggesting her wise and devout instruction of the young Timothy.

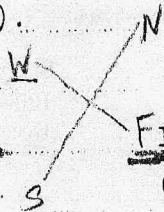
Red figures, blue field, although accents of green and gold occur in both windows to maintain a lovely balance and full palette of color. ...counter-changed with Mrs. Bean's two memorials so that the entire effect will be rich and varied. (Important: We have made a radical change in the color of the red garment, which will be quite different from Mrs. Bean's, but we do want to keep the same basic ruby and blue backgrounds for a certain degree of harmony throughout the group.)
