General Information This is an old church, small rectangular headed windows. This one faces toward the sea - south. The donors hopes the design can form a sort of Gothic head to somewhat relieve the rectangular quality.

She wants rich color, jewel-like, reds and blues, with Saint Christopher as the central theme, rather small in scale, perhaps things of the sea, such as gulls and shells in the border, fish and crafts in border.
