Father Harris likes the Nazareth Hall and St. Agatha's Phila. windows.

\*Saint Gregory is generally symbolized by two lions counter-rampant, supporting a "torteau" inscribed with a cross or the sacred monogram, IHC; although Geldart's "Manuel of Church Symbolism" puts this on a chief above three bendlets; and the Herald, Pierre LaRosa symbolized him by a single rampant lion. The cost could be reduced to around one hundred dollars in this manner.
