We are enclosing a rough sketch for one of the crosses at Barmuel.

It is patterned in the grapevine, and suggests a rather warm palette.

The other one might well emphasize the lily or the rose, and have a little cooler quality.

I think these will make lovely accents of color.

I believe it will cost us about one hundred dollars to make each of these, and I think that their installation may range between fifty and one hundred dollars each. This suggests cost from one hundred fifty to two hundred dollars each, depending upon the conditions of their installation.

I am confident we could keep them down to the lower amount by combining them with other work.
