Canopy windows.

*9/11/55, Wrska wrote: "I got templates for the nave and window 3 the lancets in the lobby...I must call your attention that these windows must be set with new double-double vents and L.O.F. Safety glass. Also a framework put on the outside for storm glass, which I will indicate on the full size drawing."

Make sketch for this window devoted to the Jesse Tree. This should be designed very much like the Jacob's Window with Jesse reclining in place of Jacob, two or three kings of Judah, and the Virgin and Child at the top of the other panel.

Wrska's in this window

This window has a tracery piece in a sort of attic above the roof, and "I see no need of doing anything with it, for it is never seen. It now has a simple leaded pattern."

East vestibule window: As planned, the large vestibule window is devoted to the Jesse Tree under the heading, - "The Tree of Life for the Healing of the Nations" and designed in harmony with the opposite vestibule window.

The reclining figure of Jesse occupies the lower part of the left lancet while the Tree extends into the right panel, supporting two Kings of Judah, one of whom could well be Jesse and might hold a harp. Above is the Blessed Virgin holding the Christ Child, and opposite is an adoring angel.

The surrounding canopy is similar to that in the opposite window.
