General Information Mr. Mitchell wrote: "It occurred to me as I left the Church the other day that with a fine window above, the plain glass in that opening over the door will strike a very incongruous note."

We have indicated two significant monograms of Our Lord for the principal openings of the fen- light, - the Chi Rho and the IHS, with stars of heavenly steadfastness in the openings above.

We have indicated this to be quite colorful, although we have in mind fairly light glass.

I should think it would not darken the vestibule too much, although possibly more white glass should be used.

Note: Simplify the design a bit in the full size drawings, keeping in mind an impression of full color, but less complicated detail. (Mr. Mitchell wrote: "It is almost impossible to see the lights except from a distance down the aisle, so detail is unimportant if color is present)."
