General Information Transfiguration theme, Medallion type, similar to the Bambino window.

See photograph of north window.

As planned, the south window is designed in the Transfiguration theme, with the radiant Christ at the center of the medallion, and Moses and Elias at either side. The field would be in character similar to the Chapel windows.

(This and the Great Physician Window complete a pair in the nave. They go side by side.)
