General Information "The Prime purpose of these windows is to cast a colored light on our reredos. The windows for this reason should not be too dark in color. At no time will it be possible for any member of our congregation to see through these windows and look directly at the sun.

(These windows to be simple - to correct the light to harmonize with the reredos glass.

Typical design for side chancel windows.

It is planned to harmonize with the glass in the reredos, and to control
and enrich the illumination, without darkening the source of light too much.

The foliated pattern flowers in the white fleur-de-lis of purity. The
flames through the center are the usual symbol of religious zeal; and
seven stars suggest the Gifts of the Spirit.
