 who is crowned and in queenly robes. The cross symbolizes  
 her virginity, and the smaller black one in her up-  
 raised hand symbolizes the rattle of the true cross which  
 was part of her dowry and for which she built the abbey  
 of Dunfermline. Below is roughly suggested her coat of  
 arms.

The surrounding field is designed in harmony with the  
 Saint Hilda window now in place, and each will beauti-  
 fully complement and enhance the other.
