General Information To have a figure similar to that of the Good Shepherd,
as shown in the Hough's Neck window, but would like it to be large
enough to be seen in the present setting.

*Very important: This window is to be artificially lighted for outside
night view from considerable distance, so the figure should be kept as
clear and simple as possible, both in the cutting and in the painting.

See photographs of other windows in place.

Although it is only a rough impression,
we feel that it will work out beautifully
in the color and light of the actual glass.

The figure of the Good Shepherd bears the
shepherd's staff, and holds the lamb.

The memorial inscription is indicated at
the base, "Gift of the Washburns".

Important note: Dr. Washburn likes the green we used in the grass in the
Holmes window, and would like to have this same shade used in his window.
