General Information To be devoted to Mary the Virgin, and Saint Elizabeth, the Mother of St. John the Baptist.

Elizabeth was not only cousin to Mary and Mother of S. John, but their destinies paralleled and it was the same Angel Gabriel who told, each in her turn, what lay ahead. Mary traveled to the home of Elizabeth and remained with her several months before her Son was born, so their relationship was close.

Floor plan on sheet #3630.

We have completed the rough color sketch for the Turner Memorial Window, and are sending it to you herewith.

As planned, it is devoted to Mary, the Mother of Our Lord, and Saint Elizabeth, the Mother of Saint John the Baptist. The latter holds the distaff.

The shield below the Virgin is inscribed with her traditional monogram, *MP*; and the anchor of Hope is designed beneath Saint Elizabeth.

Kneeling angels bear ribbons inscribed with their names, and angels of Praise are represented in the tracery.

Following the plan to alternate the two background patterns established in the first two windows, this one is designed in the rose pattern, similar in character to the window devoted to Saints James and John.

Although we have not indicated it, the memorial inscription would be designed across the base as in the present windows. We shall be glad to have this text when it is available.
