General Information Saint Mark. To go next to the Bartow window. (Saint Matthew), so it will have the alternating color scheme.

See photographs and color plates of windows in place.

As in the companion windows, Saint Mark occupies the dominant position, holding the evangelistic pen and book inscribed with his traditional symbol, the winged lion.

Below he is represented with another of Our Lord's followers on a missionary journey. Around them is the text from Saint Mark 16:20: "They went forth, and preached...the Lord working with them."

The memorial inscription is inscribed across the base, "In Memory of Carlton W. ~~W.~~ Brown, 1877-1943".
