We have prepared a color sketch to give a suggestion of our proposed treatment for the window over the entrance in Saint Anthony's Church, Manchester, and are sending it to you herewith:

Our first thought had been to glass each opening with a single sheet of glass, but these prove to be pretty large, and we think they would not look well without breaking up the color tones in the various sections.

Therefore, we have prepared this design for simple leaded patterning and color variation.
