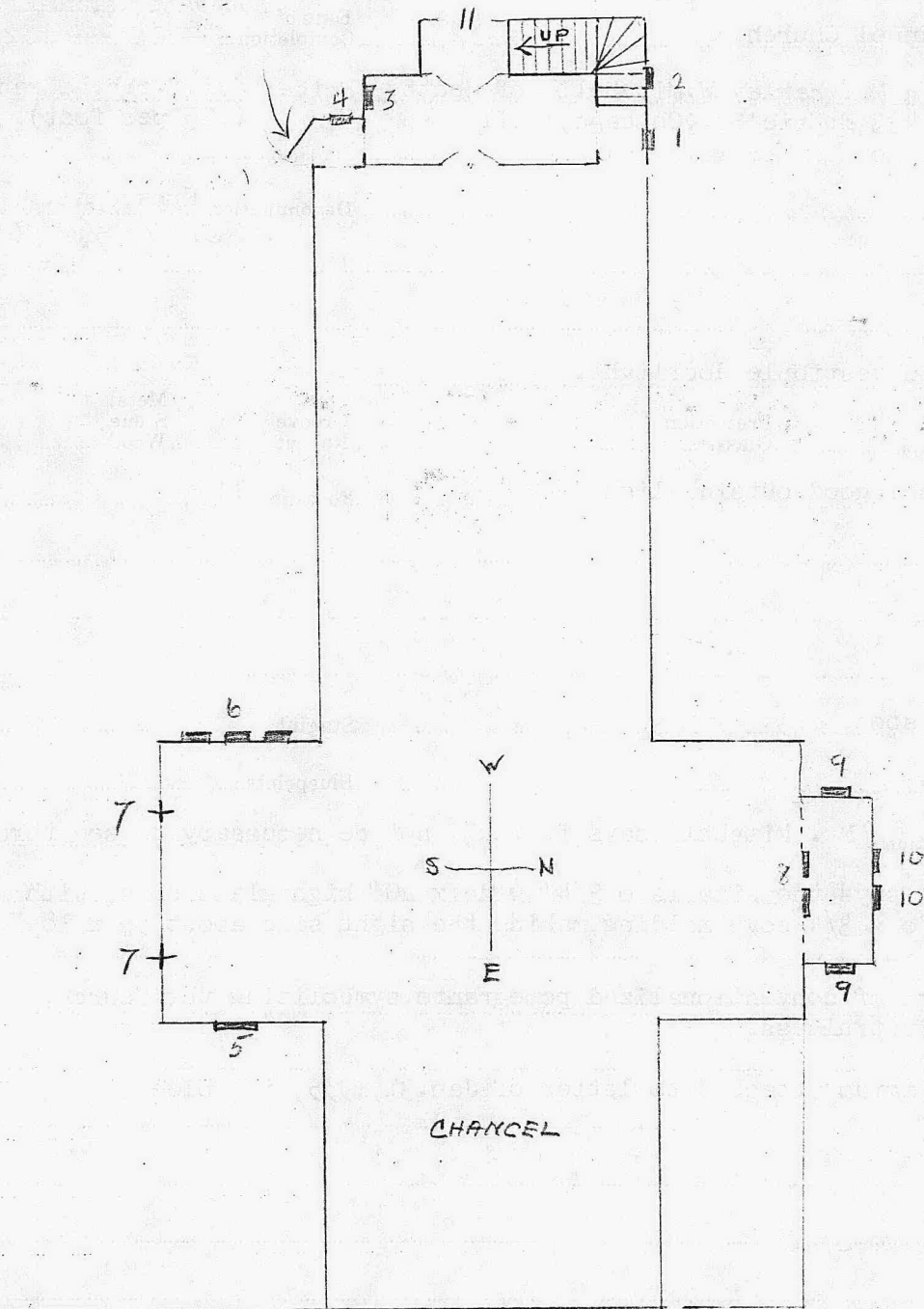
General Information Mr. Mitchell says it would not be necessary to see through it.
