General Information This window is seen at close range - to "be of fine detail, or small scale, mosaic in character. This window is in the stairway and will have no relationship to anything else in the Cathedral."

This window is to be a memorial to Arthur Biggs, organist of the Cathedral, who passed away a few years ago.

To have a member of the angelic choir at an organ - done in brilliant sparkling colors, - to include a text from the 150th Psalm. "Praise Him with stringed instruments and organs."

We have completed our study of the design for the little choir window, the memorial to your organist, Arthur Hogg, and are sending you the color sketch herewith.

It is done at two-inch scale, so it looks pretty big, but actually it will be in jewelled detail.

It features a number of the angelic choir at the organ. He is accompanied by other members above with various musical instruments; and the text from the 150th Psalm, "Praise Him with stringed instruments and organs."

I hope you like it, for it will make a wonderfully brilliant and sparkling little window.
