Frame to be made and fitted by carpenter. To be painted white on outside, mahogany brown on inside to match woodwork. BE SURE TO USE WHITE PUTTY ON OUTSIDE.

Use the cartoon of the Concord, Mass window. They want a red border.

This window is the same size as the aisles - see photographs of them.

Mr. Mainini has prepared a rough sketch for your new window with the figure of the Good Shepherd very similar to the one you like.
