The Church is dark stained, and sits back from the road on the right. There is a white sign on the grass near the church.

We have prepared a rough color sketch indicating the design of the windows as they are at either side of yours, with the Good Shepherd medallion in the dominant position. We think it has worked out very well and will make a lovely window, forming a beautiful central motif with those at either side.
