As planned, the figure of the Welcoming Christ is represented at the center, with members of the Angelic Choir at either side, symbols of the Old and New Testaments, - the Ark of Noah and Peter's Barque with the sail inscribed with the cross, and the monogram of Our Lord, - the Chi Rho and ~~XPC~~ Canterbury Cross.

Dr. Foot would like the Canterbury Cross in the extreme right panel instead of the present monogram, XPC.
