General Information This window will be a continuation of the lower "Parable of the Sower" window, and should be designed in harmony with it.

The symbolic themes in the three upper panels should include the following suggestion - the use of trumpets, harp (Lyre), and other musical symbols.

This window is in memory of a man who was primarily a musician.

BE SURE TO KEEP IN MIND THE TEXTURE AND DENSITY OF THIS EAST SIDE, AND BE SURE IT HAS THE SAME VALUE AS THE LOWER WINDOW. THERE IS A DIFFERENCE OF TREATMENT FOR THE EAST AND WEST WINDOWS. THE WEST SIDE HAS DECIDEDLY LESS OUTSIDE LIGHT, AND THE EAST SIDE HAS AN ABUNDANCE OF LIGHT.

We have completed the color sketch for your balcony window, the one nearest the chancel on the east side, above the Parable of The Sower.

As suggested, its theme is Music, with musical instruments - the harp or lyre at the center, an ancient form of the viol at the left, and a pair of bells at the right.

At the center is the inscription, "In Memory of Frank R. Boyd."
