Lettering whites and warm whites

We have completed our study of the design for the second passageway window at Christ Church, and are glad to be able to send you the color sketch before the parish meeting next Sunday.

It is planned as a companion window to the one we are now developing devoted to the Blessed Virgin and Holy Child.

It represents the forerunner of Our Lord, Saint John the Baptist. Dressed in rustic garments of the wilderness, he bears the rustic crossed staff and shell of Baptism.

Below is the symbol of his Baptism of Our Lord. Saint John stands beside Christ baptizing Him, while rays of Divine light descend upon Him from the Dove of the Holy Spirit. With them is the significant text, - "He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost."

A space for a memorial inscription is indicated at the base.

Planned to harmonize with the others, it is devoted to Martha of Bethany. She holds the basket of fruit and the keys of the household.

In the surrounding field are the symbols of the fern, the broken column, and the lamb.

Below is the raising of Lazarus with Our Lord and the kneeling figures of the sisters, Mary and Martha; and the text, - "I am the resurrection and the life.... Believeest thou this."

At the base is inscribed "In Memoriam."
