The Title of this window is **THE SUFFERING OF HIS PASSION AND DEATH (Hebrews 2:9)**

General Information **No canopy to be used - not very wide borders; that is no emphasis on borders. keep windows rather light - but the Northwest window lightest; that is, the <sup>Ascension</sup> crucifixion, for it gets no sun.**

Church has light cream walls, and dark woodwork, pews and ceiling. Chancel window is by Henry Wynd Young. It is a large wide single Gothic head opening, with lots white, some blue figures, some red, greens, charcoal blacks, and a little gold - of a great many small standing figures, with enthroned Christ at the center - no borders. Small inscription at the base. There are 3 principal windows in which shall be the transepts and opposite the chancel. The central and larger lancet of the window opposite the chancel has a large figure of S. Luke, with flowery and cloudy background, some beautiful little ferns and flowers, and canopy at the base and very golden. All the windows have metal frames, narrow, but with provision for protection glass. Vents in the bottoms of all. But the frames are pretty old, and they want to eliminate them all, having new ventilators about the same size.

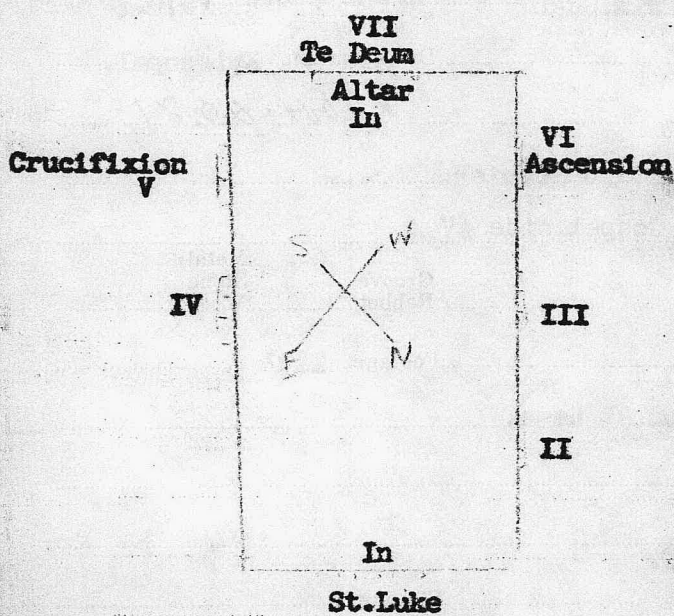
We would have to take out the metal frames and set the glass directly in the s furnishing the new vents.
