Rough sketches for the lower windows.

I am not quite sure whether you had in mind the Diocesan seal or the Church seal for the lower one over the entrance. As you will see, we have indicated the Diocesan seal, but the other could be represented just as well. In either case I think it should be articulated as clearly and as directly as possible to be legible in the distance at which it is seen. Small crosses accent the simple field and lead to the larger cross designed in the smaller window above. Here again, bold definitions and luminous glasses are needed for artificial lighting.
