General Information Panels measure  $26\frac{1}{2}$  x  $13\frac{1}{2}$ . There is a wooden division between the two panels. Allow 1/2" stop.

To be devoted to Mary and Martha.

\*later Dr. Christie wrote: "Please keep in mind that the glass measurements of these panels, including the space for the lead on the edges, is  $13\frac{1}{2}$  inches by  $26\frac{1}{2}$  inches. (That is the full size)

As planned, they are devoted to Our Lord's friends, the sisters of Bethany, Mary and Martha.

Mary is represented in an attitude of prayer, while Martha holds a vase of flowers for the altar.

They are suggested very light and brilliant, though colorful, to take advantage of all the available illumination.
