General Information 1/ Consult about simple Cathedral glass to use in the large front window opposite the chancel and the side windows. - A large gable window in front, wooden frames; about 6 side windows - four on one side and two on the other.

Lightish brown ceiling and a little lighter woodwork. They will have brown pews.

Suggested some neutral tones, perhaps warm grays, probably German Cathedrals with textures and shading - the large pieces in the front window are 30" x 42 1/2"; full glass size. They may have leaded inserts later on.
