General Information To have figures of Mary, Lazarus, and Martha.

In previous wds we omitted the vent in central panel, and retained the outer vent. Check on this. In 1953 Seale said vent are needed + suggested new ones on future wds. See about this when sending designs

The second design is devoted to Our Lord's friends of Bethany, the sisters Martha and Mary, and their brother Lazarus.

Mary holds the vase of precious ointment, while Martha bears implements of her household service.

Lazarus, at the center, stands in reverence, as though at the entrance of the tomb, with the grave-clothes at his feet.

Again, the foliated rose pattern enriches the field, and spaces are designed for the memorial inscriptions.
