This window goes next to Calling Disciples.

Windows set in wood, hinged at sides and open out.

As planned, it is devoted to Saint Andrew, who holds his symbol, the traditional diagonal cross.

He stands before the sea with a boat and a suggestion of the old fish houses. Before making the full size drawings, we would go up and photograph them for clearer identification.

In the field below is a book inscribed with the cross, and a suggestion of floral pattern.
