lower symbol.

We have made designs for the two side panels - The left panel is
devoted to the Prophets, and the right panel (ordered), is devoted to the
Nativity - see design.

This window to be in harmony with the windows in place, and with the
designs made for the side panels of this window.

As planned, it is devoted to Pentecost. The Apostles stand, with Saint Peter at the center, each with the flame of Divine inspiration at his head.

Above is the descending Dove of the Holy Spirit, and below, the phoenix rising anew from the flames of its nest, traditional symbol of the Resurrection and Ascension.

The field is designed to harmonize with the window at either side.

We will maintain the appearance in the lower part similar to the windows at either side.
