Center panel of Angel of Prayer, Censer, in plate

General Information We are to make design for the side panels of the side chancel with the censer in the center panel, placed years ago - see photographs and color plate.

Have angels with red wings to balance those with the blue wings in the companion window. Use the lines from the Te Deum as follows: "To thee all Angels cry aloud" in one panel and "the Heavens, and all the Powers therein" on the scroll of the other angel. These lines precede those we are using on the companion window.

sketch for your second side chancel window and are sending it to you, herewith. This includes the present central panel with side panels in harmony with the companion window, but with the ruby and blue in alternating positions; that is, where ruby is used as a background with blue border lines in the first, their position is transposed in the second. This is also in harmony with the color transpositions in the central panels.

For the text on the ribbons held by the Angels in the side panels, we have in mind another verse from the Te Deum:

~~.....~~
"Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God of Saboath, Heaven and Earth are full of the majesty of Thy Glory".

~~We think the best companion phrase for this window would be, - "To thee all Angels cry aloud...the Heavens and all the Powers therein"; or, - "We praise Thee O God, we acknowledge Thee to be the Lord". However, both of these precede the first. Would it be possible to transpose one of these inscriptions with the earlier text in the first or left window?~~
