General Information Pair of front doors - Ark, Barque. 4327
Pair of Chapel doors to office hall - Pelican and Phoenix. 4327
Inner Door from office hall to Church - Anchor, Cross, Globe and C55s. 4327

These are to be filled from time to time. They are set in wood with removable stop beads. Each 5 1/2" wide by 21 3/8" high, full; 5" x 21" sight. To have small plaques instead of inscriptions, which rector will furnish.

"...Noah's Ark of the Old Testament and Peter's Barque of the New Testament with sail inscribed with the cross, for the inner front doors. For the pair of doors from the Chapel to the office hall we have suggested the traditional symbols of Sacrifice and Resurrection, the Pelican feeding its young and the Phoenix rising anew from the flames of its nest.

Then...there are three single doors for which we have indicated the globe surmounted by the cross, symbolizing Our Lord's domination over the world, and the sketches are made at 2-inch scale.
