General Information We are to make a revised design for these two, with
Noah's Ark in one, and Peter's Barque in the other.

See photograph of center window in the narthex - these two go at either
side of it.

As suggested, they symbolize Noah's Ark and Peter's Barque.

Animals look out the windows of the Ark of the Old Testament and the Dove returns with the olive branch.

The sail of Peter's Barque of the New Testament is inscribed with the cross.

Provision is made for brief memorial inscriptions in case they are required.
