Christ the King, on a lovely and colorful decorative pattern.

We would like to see a majestic figure of Our Lord as the dominant symbol. We have represented Him crowned and holding the orb surmounted by the cross, traditional symbol of His power and domination over the world.

Below is the sacred monogram I.H.C., and the trefoil and triangle of the Trinity.

Stars of heavenly steadfastness accent the blue field, with the flame of divine zeal above. The border is patterned with the grapevine motif, suggesting the unity and fruitfulness of the Church, through Our Lord's significant words, - "I am the vine, ye are the branches."

The descending Dove of the Holy Spirit enriches the rose at the top.
