"As planned, the first, ~~nearest~~, the chancel is devoted to Moses and the Giving of the Law. Moses is represented with the Tablets of the Commandments. Descending rays of light from Heaven suggest their Divine sources. Above is the brazen Serpent raised in the wilderness, and below, the Burning Bush."

(Note: See tracing in folder for modifying symbol of Serpent.)

IMPORTANT: When this window is ordered and design returns to us, be sure to change to the alternating color scheme. The window will now be placed third from chancel instead of second. (Between Samuel and Kings). That is, this Moses window should have the opposite color scheme from the Samuel window. (Color sketch lost, so we will have to work from the photostat.)
