General Information... Make design for typical pair. ~~These are to be devoted to The Four Major Prophets, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Daniel and Ezekiel, with their symbols. Depart somewhat from the aisle window treatment, with a degree of harmony.~~

First pair to be devoted to Solomon and Isaiah. This will be for the Southerly pair.

We have completed our study of the designs for your south narthex windows and are sending you the rough color sketch, herewith.

As planned, it is devoted to the Old Testament leaders, King Solomon and the Prophet Isaiah.

Solomon, in royal attire, crowned and bearing the sceptre, holds the symbol of his Temple. The lamp above symbolizes his wisdom, while below, he overlooks the ships of his Navy referred to in I Kings 9:26, and II Chronicles 8:17-18.

Isaiah holds the tongs and coal of fire with which the Angel cleansed his lips. He bears the Scroll of his prophecies. The symbol above is the saw, reputed instrument of his martyrdom. The medallion below records the significant incident when the Angel purified his lips with fire.

The field is designed in geometric and foliated pattern, somewhat different from that in the nave, but in over-all harmony with it.

A space is provided at the base for the memorial inscription.

Note: In the fields ~~we~~ are to use the words "Scholar" in the Solomon panel; and "Preacher" in the Isaiah panel."
