To be carried out with related incidents. See photographs of windows in place. To be same arrangement as the other aisle windows.

Following the established plan, one is devoted to Saint Mark who bears the Evangelistic pen, and book inscribed with his traditional Lion.

In the dominant medallion below, as companion of Paul and Barnabas he preaches the Gospel to the Gentiles.

His conversion by Saint Peter is indicated in the small lower medallion, while in the one above he acts as Scribe for Saint Peter.

At the top he is symbolized as the founder and first Bishop of the church at Alexandria.

Again, ^{Cherubim} Seraphim accent the foliated pattern through the fields, and the border is enriched with stars of heavenly steadfastness and flaming roses of Divine zeal.
