Although your Architects have not sent us the measurements of the other window we have gone ahead with your suggestion that it is somewhat shorter and narrower than the others and have prepared the color sketch with the central symbol of the lily surrounded by the text, - "I am the resurrection, and the life".

As in the other window a space is planned for a memorial inscription.

The general color note is warm to harmonize with the existing windows...."

The donors would like to see the lily with three blossoms - Eliminate two of the leaves and put in two blossoms, retaining only two leaves.
