We have completed our study of the design for the north aisle window devoted to Our Lord's friends of Bethany, the sisters Martha and Mary, and are sending you the color sketch berewith.

Mary is represented scated and reading, while Martha is engaged in household duties with a truy of things for the table nearby.

Above is the distaff; and below, the book is inscribed with the text from Seizt Luke, - "But one thing is needful."

The field is designed to harmonize with the other windows, and a space for the memorial inscription is indicated at the base.

We have emphasized the ruby, although it is well foiled with blue and the other primary colors. We visualize how beautifully this design will work out, and we are eager to develop it in the color and light of the actual glass.
