General Information The panel at the left to be ~~SAMUEL, XXVIIII, XXXIIII, XXXIIII, XXXIIII~~ Moses* with the shepherd's crook and sheep at his feet as he dwelt in the land of Midian tending Jethro's flock, when he met God in the Burning Bush.

The right panel to be Joseph bearing the silver cup which he hid in Benjamin's bag when the brothers came to Egypt for food. (Joseph panel goes nearest the tower) This is the Blades Window. (Joseph)

(See photographs of the two center panels in place. BE SURE TO INCLUDE THE NAMES OF THE FIGURES IN THE GLASS, AS WE DID EARLIER. Windows are designed in full color in simple fields of light silvery glass to admit an abundance of illumination to the narthex.

*Moses window "to be installed in south window, or that nearest the Police Station" says contract.

"Joseph goes in the north window of the narthex nearest the tower."
