typical color sketches for the two groups of windows. We have followed your plan in both cases, simply making practical their cutting and leading.

The Fish. Chalice and Host motif from the group above the altar is kept in a cool palette with blues and greens predominating. The others would be designed in the same general character and color scheme.

The dominant medallion of the larger panels is kept in much the same palette. We have suggested further leaded divisions through the field and have indicated the patterning in painted grisaille. This would be permanently fired in the glass, so that all would be vitreous and permanent. A few accents of color are indicated.

We believe we can design and make each of the seven smaller panels for four hundred, twenty dellars, and each of the six larger ones for nine hundred dellars, making a total of eight thousand, three hundred, forty dellars for all the glass, installed in the frames at the chapel.

Again we want to assure you that we can adequately control the light in designs of this type without sacrificing the inherent glossy quality of the material.
