We have completed our study of the design for your aisle window and are sending you the rough color sketch, herewith.

As planned, it is devoted to the Healing Miracles of Our Lord. We have taken our theme from the fourth verse of Saint Matthew's ~~twenty-fourth~~ Chapter, -  
"And his fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and those which were possessed with devils and those which were lunatick, and those that had palsy; and he healed them."

Our Lord stands in the central panel healing a cripple, while many people who have come to Him for help are grouped in the side panels.

The panels are set in decorative architectural forms to harmonize with the other windows.

~~A space for the memorial inscription is designed across the base.~~

We believe we can make this window at a cost of two thousand dollars which, with Mr. Schurman's additional cost for the new framework, would make totals of two thousand, four hundred, twenty-five dollars in wooden frames, or two thousand, five hundred and seventy-five in stone.
