General Information Window to be devoted to Saint Margaret of Scotland - we are to develop the figure panel only - to be set in the opalescent surrounding background.

All the windows are opalescent, except the panel furnished by Barrie - the Resurrection Angel, nearest the chancel on the Gospel side. This Saint Margaret panel will go next to the Raphael window, which is low palette; the window nearest the chancel is devoted to Saint Stephen, in bright red.

Mrs. Douglas Robertson likes lavender, but Mrs. Stuart Robertson likes reds and blues. (She has seen the mediaeval Cathedrals), so do not over-do the lavender, but get in some. Try to keep it to the \$1400 price.

They saw and liked the Highland Park St. Margaret, which we are now developing.

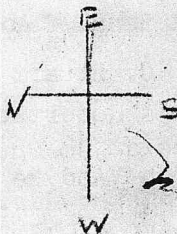

As planned, it is devoted to Saint Margaret of Scotland. She carries the sceptre and wears the crown as Queen. She holds the cross to which she was devoted. Her lavender cloak is trimmed with ermine over her rich, blue garment.

A rugged mountainous landscape is suggested in the background, with growing flowers at either side.

The color photographs I took of the other windows came out very well so we have excellent records at hand for reference while developing this window.

Criticisms of the design: Feet hands and feet too large. We have assured them that we would make the hands smaller, and also the feet - just showing the slippers. A little longer garment. Slippers same color as cloak.
