General Information To be devoted to The Resurrection, with the

Risen figure of Christ in the right-hand panel, and the three Marys in the left-hand panel, very much like the arrangement in the Youngstown windows.

IMPORTANT. They want to be sure about the face of Christ. It is to be the same type as the one in the Blessing Children panel.

*The Church arranged for the placing of the protection on the earlier windows.

As planned, the risen Christ is represented in one panel bearing the cruciform banner of victory over death, while the three Marys are grouped opposite with the Angel of the Tomb before them.

This rough sketch suggests color and light in action and does not represent the exquisite detail of line and form that will characterize the actual glass. For instance, the faces are only roughly indicated at this small scale. The features of the Christ will be developed in harmony with our other windows, as will the surrounding architectural "canopy" with its Angels of Praise and Prayer bearing trumpet and censer.
