General Information Lion as the symbol for Strength - and the Wheel for Perfection.

*To be installed in new sash to be provided and sent to us.

As planned, the Lion of Strength is the central symbol with shields inscribed with the Cross of Faith.

Below is the Tower, another symbol of Strength, and above, the Wheel of Perfection.

The foliated pattern through the field is designed in the grapevine suggesting the unity and fruitfulness of the Church through Our Lord's significant words, - "I am the vine, ye are the branches".

At the base is the conventionalized open book with space for a memorial inscription.

This is in harmony with our window new in place. In fact, the over-all design is in basic harmony with the other window.
