General Information Sketch sent October 30, 1963, showing how window will look when altered - removing four feet from the bottom.

"It will cut at the middle of the lily symbol and this half section would be redesigned to take the memorial inscription. The lettering could actually be considerably smaller, but it is difficult to indicate on this small scale. As it is, it would scale well with the lettering in the opposite window.

The ventilators can be omitted from the side panels, or they can be retained.

...We have cut the window to the point indicated on Mr. Woodward's drawing. We are not quite clear about the two foot, three inch structure above this, indicated in the section drawing. It would seem to obstruct the window. No doubt the architect has made provision for illuminating that portion."

They are building a new parish house onto the church, which will eliminate at least the ventilator section from our window. They want to have the memorial inscription in the section just above the ventilator, a space about 9 inches, redesign it on the straight lines. There are said to be ventilators high up in the side windows. Their thought is to eliminate them, and move

some of the glass up in that section..."

Dec. 5, 1963. Left 2 sketches with Dr. Karsten - discussed two ways of doing it - one with the Angel partly obscured, and the other, with the Angel raised.

Note: We also made a design for the inscription to be placed in the Hazzard window - first window in the nave on the left-hand side (the north side of the Church) - "To the Glory of God and In Memory of Edna G. Littlefield Hazzard, December 3, 1873 - August 14, 1963." ... "We think it should be designed through the field of the lowest circle, around the symbol of the bird's nest, in the manner of the opposite window, - the Gardner memorial. This will necessitate removing the ventilator section and bringing it back here for the alterations..."
