The plan for the series is the Old and New Testament theme in each pair.

Entire series to be devoted to Old and New Testament incidents, in each window.

The Kindling of Elijah's Altar with fire from Heaven. (I Kings 18:37).  
and Pentecost (Acts 2:1-4) with the flames at the forehead of each.

They are planned within the arrangement of subjects devoted to the Old and New Testaments, from the Creation and the Nativity to Isaiah's Vision and the Ascension of Our Lord.

#### Elijah and Pentecost

One sketch suggests the window beside the one now in place, toward the chancel. It represents the miraculous Fire from God upon Elijah's Sacrificial Altar. - "That this people may know <sup>the</sup> Lord God", (1 Kings 18:38); and Pentecost. Saint Peter stands in the foreground of the group of Apostles with the cloven tongues of fire of the Holy Ghost above. - "And they all were filled with the Holy Ghost."

The symbols below represent the Hand of God from the Sea referred to in I Kings 18:44; and the Corn and Tablets of the Law, recalling the Corn Harvest and the Giving of the Law, commemorated at Pentecost.
