One sketch suggests the window beside the one now in place, toward the chancel. It represents the miraculous Fire from God upon Elijah's Sacrificial Altar.—
"That this people may know . the Lord God", (1 Kings 18:38): and Pentecost. Saint Peter stands in the foreground of the group of Apostles with the cloven tongues of fire of the Holy Ghost above. — "And they all were filled with the Holy Ghost."

The symbols below represent the Hand of God from the Sea referred to in I Kings 18:44; and the Corn and tablets of the Law, recalling the Corn Harvest and the Giving of the Law, commemorated at Pentecost.
