Dear Dr. Gorsuch:

We are glad to have your good message of May twenty-seventh with the very helpful information about conditions related to the windows. We appreciate and thank you for the measurements of the door panel and transom; and the fine diagram.

We have completed the design for the group next to the one now in place, including the two ordered. It is designed in full color with ruby predominating.

We are planning the next group in a predominance of blue, but with sufficient ruby to balance nicely. This alternation of color would continue through the series.

The first at the right is devoted to the Boy Jesus in the Temple with the Doctors. Above is the symbol of the Temple Lamp.

The memorial inscription is, - "Pearl Alice Madden, 1896-1963".

The central panel represents the Baptism of Our Lord by Saint John the Baptist, who is clothed in rough garments and carries the rustic crossed staff. He holds the Shell of Baptism over Our Lord's head. The descending Dove of the Holy Spirit is symbolized above.

The memorial inscription, - "In loving Memory of my mother, Rebecca Helton Burchfield, Mrs. DeForrest Herman Bonsted". In your first message the name DeForrest was indicated with a small "f", while the second had a capital, while the middle name Herman has one "r" and two "r's". Will you please check these, for we would like to be sure about the spelling.

The third panel represents Our Lord's Temptations. He stands on the mountain top, while Satan offers him the earthly crown of the kingdoms of the world. Above is the ministering Angel; and in the transom, the globe surmounted by the Cross, symbol of Our Lord's power and domination.

We are developing color sketches for the rest of the windows and look forward to the pleasure of sharing them with you, soon. With them, we are studying the group to symbolize Christianity related to modern life, in the manner you suggest.
