General Information

We have completed our study of the designs for the two new windows and are sending you the rough color sketches herewith. We have kept in mind the general character and color of the rose window and feel they will work out in lovely harmony.
If you think a little more ruby and gold should be included as in the rose, it could be introduced in the outer border line where we now have blue.
Only the symbol of the Crown is indicated for the second window in place of the medallion occupied by the Burning Bush in the complete rendering.
