General Information This panel is a companion to the Micah and Zachariah window already installed.

Hosea is represented in the upper left medallion holding the prophetic scroll inscribed, "Return unto the Lord thy God" (Hosea 14:1).

Below, at the left, Amos holds the shepherd's crook; balanced by Zachariah with staff of authority.

Symbols in the foliated pattern below are related to the Prophets above, - The flaming rose of Charity for Hosea; suggesting God's forgiveness of Israel; and a sheep for Amos;

In the bases are other symbols of the Prophets, - the calf of Samaria shattered as Hosea prophesied (Hosea 8:6), and the scroll and pen suggesting Amos as the first of the writing Prophets.
