Mr. Mainini was glad to have the pleasure of meeting you and to consider with you the wonderful possibilities for colorful and significant enrichment of your Chapel windows.

He is studying all of them in harmonious relation and has completed rough color sketches for two of the smaller rectangular ones. These are designed in decorative patterns of the flowers and shrubs on the cemetery grounds. One is devoted to the Rhododendron and Dogwood, and the other to the Tulip.

He has in mind somewhat similar and related plans for the other two windows. He is working on designs for the larger altar window with the Ascension of Our Lord as the dominant theme carried out in deep, rich color; also the vestibule window with the three Virtues, - Faith, Hope, and Charity, in a lighter background accented with passages of pure, rich color.

We will send you his suggestions as they develop. In the meantime, you may wish to have these first at hand for possible reference.

We are eager to develop the entire plan and to carry it out in distinguished light and color.

\* The Tulip window suggests a cost of nine hundred dollars, while the Rhododendron and Dogwood might be a little more, - nearer one thousand dollars.
