General Information To have Angels of Praise and Prayer with trumpet - in attitude of praying.

Actual subjects to be decided later.

These two panels measure 7" x 30" sight.

"We talked about the possibility of later figures such as Augustine, Francis, and up to more modern ones such as Luther; or Biblical incidents, or Children of the Old and New Testaments, or allegorical figures of Service, Worship, Truth, etc.

(Note: send Dr. Washburn name of Everett Church where we have artificial lighting.)

A third sketch suggests the smaller companion windows in the narthex at either side of the entrance; enriched with members of the angelic choir - angels of praise and prayer.

Or, they could well be allegorical figures of Service, Worship, Truth, - and, again, could be accompanied by appropriate texts, perhaps from the Psalms, such as "Enter into His Gates with thanksgiving - and into His courts with praise;" or "Serve the Lord with gladness - come before His presence with singing".
